

#### IIA Snowcem Awards for Excellence in Urban Architecture - 2000.

The IIA Snowcem Award is given to two architects every year whose design ability have been withstood the challenge of excellence in Urban Architecture, in two categories, i.e. Public/Commercial Building and Housing Project categories. Even for the 2000 award, from the various entries received, the jury panel could not find a suitable entry in the housing project. However, there were two outstanding entries in the Public/Commercial Building Category, which the jury panel thought, are fit enough to get the award for the year. The winners were Ar. Hemant Mahajan of Pune for his project, Pre-Preprimary, Primary & Secondary School at Mayur Colony, Pune and Ar. N.M. Salim & Associates for their project, International Convention Centre at Maradu, Kochi, The award carried a plaque, certificate and cheque of Rs.15,000/- each to the winners.

The Jury Panel consisted of Ar. Vinay M. Parelkar, Ar. Vasant B. Ranade, Ar. Sharad Y. Madan, Ar. Pradeep Ambekar and Mr. Prakash F. Nagori.

PHILOSOPHY: In the 13 years of practice, have handled a variety of projects such as Architectural & Interior Designing of bungalows, Residential complexes, Institutional campus, Industrial campus in and around Pune, Nagpur, Kolhapur and Mumbai, Indore, Sangamner.

Any project whether it is Architectural, Interior designing or campus planning, which works out successful if the client gets a total satisfaction. This is possible only if one can get deeply involved in the project and study all the clients requirements from the initial stage of planning and designing of ultimate user.

This practice will definitely give birth to a complete design in terms of function, form, utility and aesthetics.

The project may be small one or large scale, it must be given same importance and attention to achieve the high standards of design and quality.

#### Award winning project - Bal Shikshan Mandir Campus, Kothrud, Pune Introduction:

The school campus is of 3.36 acres, located in the fastest newly developed residential area amidst Pune city. A rectangular plot with 18 m wide road along the eastern side of the campus, the side does not boast of sizable contours and is a plane table land. The site has Murum and Shadu type of soil.

#### Design Requirements:

The school wanted the classroom of 40 students each with only 2 classrooms per division. Thus the school can give attention to the students and control over the quality of education along with recreational facility.

#### Facilities:

Facilities like stainless steel water tank for drinking water, water pond/sand pit landscaped areas, partially covered pergolas, paved and pathways food playground, etc. had to provided.

Main School Building:

The main school building is designed around a hierarchy of open spaces as courtyards which are conceived as an extension to the teaching activity.

The three wings are self sufficient and are interlocked with these courts bringing in natural light, wind along with meeting spaces for everyone.

All the three wings with the courtyards coverage in to the main centre court to form the gathering space for all. These courtyards allow visual communication and continuity to other areas. The building facade depicts the modern elements brought out of traditional elements of exposed brick with arches in proportion to the main framework, breaking the monotory of the straight lines.

The arrangement of internal spaces is worked out such as to get necessary shade areas by means of pergola giving the required depth to the building at various points.

The main building is connected to the existing dining and a multipurpose hall to the right binds the two buildings giving space for parking underneath. It is set up at the rear side of the campus making way for the playground and swimming pool, thus enabling the required foreground to appreciate the facade and facilitate various school activities.
